Paths	English	Unit: Going to the Seaside: We will solve word puzzles using seaside vocabulary. Yr 2 will also recognize and write acrostic poems using seaside vocabulary. The children will get the opportunity to write a holiday postcard from the Victorian era. Spelling: Revision
	Mathematics	Yr 2 will use practical and informal ways to support multiplication and division. We will present multiplication as repeated addition and division as repeated subtraction. We will also be solving problems using multiplication and recall 2x, 10x and 5x tables with their related division facts. Yr 2 will find the unknown numbers in multiplication and division number sentences.
	Science	Changing shape: Children will learn to understand and explore melting ice using appropriate senses. They will be using their knowledge about what makes ice melt to plan an experiment. They will learn to recognise what would make a test unfair and to use their results to draw a conclusion about which place is warmest.
	Topic	Unit: Going to the seaside will teach children to name and investigate places and to relate them to different types of environments. They will learn where the seaside is in relation to their locality. They will get the opportunity to reach conclusions from evidence and to organise a survey.
