## YEAR 11 YEAR END REPORTS

Dear Parent/Guardian

Please find enclosed your child's final school reports. On their reports are this year's mock exam results and their predicted grades for their summer examinations. For some students a cause for concern letter has been issued pertaining to a subject for which you will need to complete and return to their subject teacher, on the understanding that improvements need to be addressed.

### Subject Choices

Subject teachers have now completed examination entries based upon your child's progress. You will also receive a statement of entry showing which exam and at which level (for some subjects (Extended or Core)) your child has been entered for. Please check all Cambridge entries before the 21<sup>st</sup> of February to ensure you agree with the subject teacher's recommendation.

If you disagree with this entry choice, as a parent you have every right to contest this decision, you will understand that the school cannot take responsibility if your child is not successful in the event of an award change.

### Dropping Subjects

Below is an extract from the schools Rules & Regulations policy

- Yr11 students may, following the advice of their subject teacher and parents, drop a subject to concentrate on subjects they will hopefully pass at examination level.
- If a subject is dropped by a Year 11 student, he or she must nevertheless continue to attend the same subject and class appointments, but conduct independent study and other work in silence at the back of the classroom, unless otherwise advised.

**Written permission**, (from the Parent) must be given to the Head of Key Stage four after discussion from the Head of relevant Subject.

**I would *strongly advise* against your child dropping a subject, if there is a strong chance they will pass it.**

In addition we recommend only one failing subject be dropped to concentrate other subjects.

Please be advised entry to the sixth form is 5 A\*-C pass including English and Mathematics. With a desired B grade or above in the chosen subject at A level.
